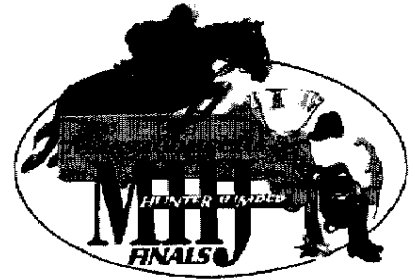

## QUALIFICATION:

- No membership is required.
- Riders qualify by accumulating 10 or more points in the Massachusetts Hunter Jumper Medal classes held at recognized shows.
- MHJ Points are scored 10, 8, 6, 4, 2, and 1 regardless of the classification of the show. To qualify: 10 points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class.
- Medal finals competition is open to all exhibitors who have qualified by August 27, 2011.

## GENERAL CLASS REQUIREMENTS:

Warm Up at the Finals:

- Ride only the posted course!
- Trainers may ride in the warm-up.
- Trainers may stand in the ring at a marked designated area.
- one round, only if time allows, after all the first rounds are finished a second round may be allowed.
- A rider may be disqualified, if any associate moves or changes the height of a jump.
- NO REFUND/SCRATCHES FOR ANY REASON AFTER 8 AM ON AUGUST 26TH**
- Juniors may not complete in both the Junior Medal and the Mini-Medal at the same show or the finals.
- At the Judge's discretion, exhibitors may be required to compete in a second phase.



### 350. MHJ Short Stirrup Medal

Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders may not compete in any other equitation class at any show and shall not have competed in a class jumping over 18" in height. To be shown over 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". The fences shall be cross rails or verticals with no combinations. Riders may not cross enter into any other medal classes at the MHJ Finals. Ten points are required to qualify for the finals. To fill a class and for points to count at least two riders must complete the course. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 8. After August 8, 2011, only those riders not qualified may continue to compete in the class.

### 351. MHJ Adult Mini-Medal

Open to all Adult Amateur riders that have not shown over a course where the fences exceeded 3' in the current year. To perform over a course of at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into the MHJ Adult Medal or the NEHJ Adult Talent Medal. To fill a class and for points to count at least two riders must complete the course. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 8. After August 8, 2011, only those riders not qualified may continue to compete in the class.

### 352. MHJ Children's Medal Pony

Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1, 2011 and who have not shown over a course where the fences have exceeded 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. A combination is optional and must be adjusted according to fence heights. The same pony must be used in all phases. Only one rider per pony (riders may not ride in more than one height section of the class). Fence heights Small/Medium 2'

and Large 2'6". Competitors may not cross enter in the MHJ Mini-Medal at the Finals. Ten points are required to qualify for the finals. To fill a class and for points to count at least two riders must complete the course. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 8. After August 8, 2011, only those riders not qualified may continue to compete in the class.

### 353. MHJ Children's Medal Horse

Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1, 2011 and who have not shown over a course where the fences have exceeded 3'. Fence heights to be set at 2'6". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences the required height including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. The same horse must be used in all phases.

Only one rider per horse. Riders may not cross enter into the MHJ-Mini Medal or NEHJ Junior Talent Medal at the Finals. To fill a class and for points to count at least two riders must complete the course. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 8. After August 8, 2011, only those riders not qualified may continue to compete in the class.

### 354. MHJ Mini-Medal

Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 15th Birthday of December 1, 2011 with the exception of Maiden and Novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1. To perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into the MHJ Children's Medal Horse or Children's Pony Medal at the finals. Ten points are required to qualify for the finals. To fill a class and for points to count at least two riders must complete the course. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 8. After August 8, 2011, only those riders not qualified may continue to compete in the class.

### 355. Open Junior Equitation

### 356. MHJ Junior Medal

Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1, 2011. Riders shall perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the Judge's discretion. Riders may cross enter into the NEHJ Junior Talent Medal. To fill a class and for points to count at least two riders must complete the course. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 8. After August 8, 2011, only those riders not qualified may continue to compete in the class.

### 359. MHJ Adult Medal 31+

Open to all Adult Amateur riders. Riders shall perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3' including a combination with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the Judge's discretion. Riders may cross enter into the NEHJ Adult Talent Medal. To fill a class and for points to count at least two riders must complete the course. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 8. After August 8, 2011, only those riders not qualified may continue to compete in the class.
