LEADLINE DIVISION (RIHA only; "C" rated)

13. LEADLINE - Open to riders 6 years of age and under. To be shown collectively at the walk and individually at the trot. To be judged with emphasis on equitation; suitability and manners of mount to be considered. Leader must be on foot and must be over 14 years of age. May not compete in any other under saddle class at this show.

14. LEADLINE SUITABILITY - Same specifications as class 13.

15. LEADLINE CHAMPIONSHIP (unrated) - Same specifications as class 13.

WALK TROT EQUITATION DIVISION*

16. WALK TROT EQUITATION - Open to riders 10 years of age and under. To be shown at a walk and trot or jog ONLY. Entries may not compete in any class requiring canter.

17. WALK TROT EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIP – Same specifications as class 16.

79. WALK TROT EQUITATION 11 & OVER (unrated) - Open to riders 11 years of age and older. To be shown at a walk and trot or jog ONLY. Entries may not compete in any class requiring canter.

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION*

Open to riders twelve years of age and under. Riders may not compete in any other equitation class at any show, and shall not have competed in a class jumping over 18" in height. Fences may be taken at a trot or canter.

11. SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION FLAT*
Walk, trot & canter. May be asked to halt and back. No more than 8 to canter at one time.

1. SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION FENCES*
To be shown at a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 fences not exceeding 18' in height; No combinations.

2. SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIP/MHJ QUALIFIER
Fences not to exceed 18"; No combinations. Must have shown in class #1 to be eligible.

LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to riders 13 years and over including amateur adults who have not competed at any other show or class where jumps have exceeded 18" in height. Fences may be taken at a trot or canter at the option of the rider.

74. OPEN EQUITATION UNDER 18 FENCES - For Juniors who have not reached their 18th birthday. Jumps not to exceed 3'. Tests 1 - 19.

75. OPEN EQUITATION UNDER 18 FENCES CHAMPIONSHIP – Same specifications as class 72.

CHILDREN'S EQUITATION DIVISION*

Open to exhibitors who are eligible for Children's Hunter. Riders may not enter into any other class at the same horse show where fences exceed 3'0". Fences for

horses and large ponies: 2'6";
small/medium ponies 2'0".

MODIFIED ADULT EQUITATION DIVISION*

Open to Amateur Adult riders who, as of December 1st of the current show year, have not won six blue ribbons at a RECOGNIZED show in Adult Equitation classes, including Adult Medal Classes, but excluding Modified Adult Classes. For amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult, if, as of December 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher within the past two show years. Fences are not to exceed 2'6". Riders in this division cannot show in any other recognized classes at the same show where fences exceed 2'6".

56. RIHA HUNT SEAT MINI MEDAL
Open to junior members of the Rhode Island Horsemen's Association who have not reached their 15th birthday and to

riders 15-17 years of age who are eligible for limit equitation over fences as of December 1 in current show year and have not competed in classes in which the entry may be required to jump higher is required to jump higher than 3'. All contestants are to compete over a course not exceeding eight fences and not less than six fences, excluding combination fences, at a height not to exceed 2'6" with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests may be requested, at the judge's discretion. (USEF Current tests 1-8). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course.

77. RIHA HUNT SEAT JUNIOR MEDAL
Open to Junior members of the Rhode Island Horsemen's Association who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3' with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1 - 19). To fill a class, at least three competitors must complete the course. One win or two seconds qualifies for the finals.

48. RIHA ADULT MINI MEDAL
Open to adult amateur riders who, as of December 1st of the current show year, have not won six blue ribbons at a RECOGNIZED show in Adult Equitation classes, including Adult Medal Classes, but excluding Modified Adult Classes. For amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult if, as of December 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher within the past two show years. Potential qualifiers will be asked to perform over at least six fences not to exceed 2'6" with no combinations. USEF Tests 1-8 may be asked at the judge's discretion. A minimum of three exhibitors must complete the course. To qualify for the finals, an exhibitor must win one class. Once qualified a rider may continue to show in this class.

71. RIHA AM. ADULT HUNT SEAT MEDAL
Open to adult amateur members of the Rhode Island's Horseman's Association. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3' with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1 - 19). To fill a class, at least three competitors must complete the course. One win or two seconds qualifies for the finals.

NEHC

78. NEHC HUNT SEAT JUNIOR MEDAL+
Open to Junior members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the Judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1 - 19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. One win required to qualify for the Finals. All contestants must wear proper attire. Once a contestant has qualified, they are no longer eligible for the qualifying classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.

72. NEHC AMATEUR ADULT HUNT SEAT MEDAL+
Open to adult amateur members of NEHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the Judge's discretion. (USEF Current Tests 1 - 19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. All contestants must wear proper attire. Once a contestant has qualified they are no longer eligible for the preliminary classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.

MHJ

55. MHJ MINI MEDAL
Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 15th birthday as of Dec. 1 of

the current year (exception Maiden and Novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of Dec. 1 of the current year). To perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders may cross-enter into the MHJ Children's Medal Horse or Pony class at the finals. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify. Once qualified you may still enter the class until Aug. 1, 2010. After Aug. 1, 2010 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class.

59. MHJ CHILDREN'S MEDAL (Combined Horses & Ponies)

Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1, 2010 and who have not shown over a course where the fences have exceeded 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. A combination is optional and must be adjusted according to fence heights. The same horse/pony must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse/pony (riders may not ride in more than one height section of the class). Fence heights Small/Medium 2' and Large/Horse 2'6". Competitors may not cross enter in the MHJ Mini-Medal or MHJ Junior Medal at the Finals. Ten points are required to qualify for the finals. To fill a class and for points to count at least two riders must complete the course. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until Aug. 1. After Aug. 1, 2010, only those riders not qualified may compete in the class.

76. MHJ JUNIOR MEDAL

Open to Junior members who have not reached their 18th birthday as of Dec. 1. All contestants are required to perform over at least 6 fences not to exceed 3' in height. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify.

47. MHJ ADULT MINI MEDAL

Open to adult amateur riders who, as of December 1st of the current show year,

have not won six blue ribbons at a RECOGNIZED show in Adult Equitation classes, including Adult Medal Classes, but excluding Modified Adult Classes. For amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult if, as of December 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher within the past two show years. Potential qualifiers will be asked to perform over at least six fences not to exceed 2'6" with no combinations. USEF Tests 1-8 may be asked at the judge's discretion. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify. Once qualified you may still enter the class until Aug. 1, 2010. After Aug. 1, 2010 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class.

70. MHJ ADULT MEDAL

Open to all Amateur Adult competitors. Riders shall perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3'0" including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify. Once qualified riders may still enter the class until Aug. 1, 2010. After Aug. 1, 2010 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class. At the Finals, class will be divided 18-30 and over 30.

Open to riders twelve years of age and under. Riders not to compete in any other class that requires jumping fences any higher than 18". To be shown over 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". The fences shall be cross rails or verticals with no combinations. To be judged on performance and soundness.

To be shown by Junior exhibitors. Junior exhibitors 15 - 17 years of age must be eligible for intermediate equitation over fences as of December 1 of the current

show year. Fences not to exceed 2' for small/medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies, 3' for horses; spreads not to exceed fence height. If entries warrant, the division may be split at the discretion of show management. Same horse/pony rider combination cannot show in any other rated division except equitation at that show. Horses may be shown by another rider in any other division or section at the same show. Ponies may not cross enter into the Regular Pony Hunter Division. Jogging for soundness at the discretion of the Judge.

To be ridden by amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as junior exhibitors. Horses may be shown by a different rider in any other division or class at the same competition. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, and suitability as an Adult Amateur Hunter. Horses and ponies may be jogged for soundness at the judge's discretion. Height of fences 3'; spreads not to exceed height of fence. Ponies may be ridden by adults, suitability to count.

CHAMPIONSHIP*

Same specifications as class #18

80. WALK TROT PLEASURE 11 & OVER (unrated)

Open to riders 11 & over. To be shown at a walk, trot or jog ONLY. To be judged on manners, suitability of horse to rider and performance.

20. WALK TROT TRAIL*

Open to riders 10 & under. To be shown at a walk, trot or jog ONLY. To be shown over a series of not more than three simple obstacles. No jumps to be used. To be scored over obstacles 60% and on the rail 40%. Entries to be sent over obstacles first.

OPEN HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE*

21. Open to all horses of hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to the status of the rider. To be shown at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness.

22. OPEN HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP

Same specifications as class #21.

23. RIHA PLEASURE (RIHA only; "C" rated)

English or Western. Open to members of RIHA to be shown walk, trot, canter or lope. Must be asked to halt and back.

24. NEHC PLEASURE (NEHC only)

Open to members of NEHC to be shown walk, trot, canter or lope. Must be asked to halt and back.

25. OPEN LADIES PLEASURE*

Riders to be 18 years of age or over. May be shown English or Western. To be shown at a walk, trot or jog and canter or lope. May be asked to back. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability.

QUARTER HORSE

26. QUARTER HORSE HUNTER U/S*

Horses to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Horses should back easily and stand quietly. Horses may change gaits at the flat-footed walk or the trot at the judge's discretion. Light contact with the horse's mouth is recommended. At the option of the judge, all or just the top eight horses may be

required to hand gallop, one or both ways of the ring. Never more than eight horses to hand gallop at one time. At the hand gallop, the judge may ask the group to halt and stand quietly on a free rein (loosened rein).

27. QUARTER HORSE PLEASURE, ENGLISH OR WESTERN, JUNIOR RIDER (RIHA only; "C" rated)

Horses to be shown at a walk, trot or jog, canter or lope on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. Horses must work both ways of the ring at all three gaits to demonstrate their ability with different leads. The judge shall have the right to ask for additional work which must be of the same nature as above. Horse must be asked to back. Rider will not be required to dismount.

28. QUARTER HORSE WESTERN PLEASURE*

To be shown at a walk, jog and lope on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. Horses must work both ways of the ring at all three gaits to demonstrate their ability with different leads. Exhibitors shall be asked to extend the jog in at least one direction. The Exhibitors shall be asked to lope with a slight increase in forward motion. Horses must work both ways of the ring at all three gaits to demonstrate their ability with different leads. Horses shall not be asked to extend the lope, but at the discrimination of the judge, they may be asked to extend the jog. Horses are required to back easily and stand quietly. Horses are to be reversed to the inside (away from the rail). They may be required to reverse at the walk or jog at the discrimination of the judge, but shall not be asked to reverse at the lope.

Judge may ask for additional work of the same nature from any horse. He is not to ask for work other than that listed above.

This class will be judged on the performance and conformation of the horse at the discretion of the judge. Entries will be penalized for excessive speed or being on wrong leads.

29. QUARTER HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP, OPEN (RIHA only; "C" rated)

Open to horses who have been entered and judged in either the Quarter Horse

Hunter Under Saddle or the Quarter Horse Western Pleasure. To be shown at the walk, trot or jog, canter or lope. Horses are required to back easily and stand quietly. Points will be awarded to appropriate Pleasure Class according to tack.

HUNTER TYPE PET PONY*

30. HUNTER TYPE PET PONY

Open to riders under 14 years of age. To be judged on manners, performance and quality at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring.

31. HUNTER TYPE PET PONY CHAMPIONSHIP

Same specifications as class #30.

JUNIOR EXHIBITOR'S HACK*

32. JUNIOR EXHIBITOR'S HACK

Open to riders under 18 years of age. To be judged on manners, performance and quality at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring.

33. JUNIOR EXHIBITOR'S HACK CHAMPIONSHIP

Same specifications as class #32.

IN HAND*

81. WESTERN HORSE IN HAND

Entries shall be judged individually standing, and then at a walk and jog on the line. Emphasis shall be placed on type, conformation, substance, quality & manners.

82. ENGLISH HORSE IN HAND

Open to Hunter and saddle-type horses, using an appropriate halter or bridle. Entries shall be judged individually standing, and then at a walk and jog on the line. Emphasis shall be placed on type, conformation, substance, quality and manners.

83. PONY IN HAND

Open to all ponies 14.2 hands and under. To be judged individually, standing and then at a walk and trot on the line. To be judged on breed type, conformation, quality, substance, way of going, disposition and manners.
