### 56. MHJ ADULT MEDAL 2'9" Entry Fee \$25.00

Open to all adult Amateur competitors. Riders shall perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3' including a combination with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Competitors may cross enter into the NEHJ Adult Talent Medal. To fill a class, at least two competitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to qualify for the finals. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until; August 1, 2009. After August 1, 2009 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class. At the finals, class will be divided 18-30 and over 30.

### 60. RIHA HUNT SEAT MEDAL Entry Fee \$25.00

Open to Junior members of the Rhode Island Horseman's Association who have not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> Birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not to exceed 3' with at least 1 change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (U.S.E.F. current tests 1-19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course.

74. NEHC JUNIOR MEDAL Entry Fee \$25.00 Open to junior members of the New England Horseman's Council who have not reached their eighteenth birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3' 3". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judges discretion (USEF Tests 1-19). To fill a class at least four competitors must complete the course. One win required to qualify for the Finals. Contestants that are qualified are no longer eligible for the preliminary classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year. \*\* Only for NEHC Show

### 57. RIHA ADULT HUNT SEAT MEDAL Entry Fee \$25.00

Open to adult amateur members of the Rhode Island Horseman's Association. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not to exceed 3' with at least 1 change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (U.S.E.F. current tests 1-17). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. Special Note: For the finals, the judge shall be required to work-off the top four contestants.

73. NEHC ADULT MEDAL Entry Fee \$25.00 Open to adult members of the New England Horseman's Council. All Contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3'. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF Test 1-19). To fill a class at least four competitors must complete the course. All contestants must wear proper attire. Contestants that are qualified are no longer eligible for the preliminary classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals that year. \*\*only NEHC show

Open to riders who are eligible to ride in the Children's Hunter Division or the Adult Amateur Hunter Division. Horse/Rider combinations may not show in any other jumper classes at this show where fences exceed 3'3". Fences not to exceed 3'3"; spreads not to exceed 3'6". All ties for other than first shall remain tied and the prize money divided equally between the ties horses. Equal points will be awarded.

### RI JUMPERS

Open to members and non-members of the RIHA R.I. Jumpers may be of any height. Classes and judging specifications same as for the Regular Jumper Division except that: at least 50% of the jumps may be raised at least 6" and not more than 12" in the breaking of ties we no faults are involved. When at least 50% of the jumps have been raised to the maximum height and spread and a tied for first place has not been broken after the horses jumped the course at this height, the contenders shall be declared tied. Prize money shall be divided and each horse shall receive equal points towards the championship. Horses that are tied for other than first place shall remain tied and the prize money shall be divided equally among the tied horses. Each horse shall receive the number of points offered for the placement for which he is tied. If time is a factor the time allowed for all competitors must be based on a maximum speed of 360 yards per minute. Maximum height of fenced is 3'6" for first round.

#### Rules and Regulations

1. Judges decisions are final.
2. The Committee reserves the right to decline any entry, and to cancel, combine, or divide classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
3. Courses will consist of post and rails, walls, gates, and pickets. Courses and jumping order will be posted at the in gate all day.
4. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
5. Any horse entered and not exhibited shall forfeit fees. There will be a \$25 fee for entries unpaid at the end of the show; and a service charge of \$50 for each returned check.
6. To be eligible for any stake class, entrants must have shown in the qualifying class over fences in that division.
7. Schooling will be permitted in authorized areas only. Anyone found violating these rules shall forfeit all entry fees and not be allowed to show.
8. The committee reserves the right to not delay classes due to conflicts and to not allow substitutions of classes or horses.
9. No exhibitor or person shall approach a Judge as to a decision or other matters unless he first obtains permission from the show steward. Any exhibitor or person disregarding this rule may be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit entry fees.
10. An open check must be presented to the show secretary before numbers will be given out.
11. Post entries will be accepted but there will be a post entry fee the day of the show.
12. All riders must wear USEF approved headgear any where on the show grounds and must have harnesses securely fastened.

Open to Amateur riders who, as of December 1<sup>st</sup> of the current show year have not won six blue ribbons at a RECOGNIZED show in Adult equitation classes, including Adult Medal Classes, but excluding Modified Adult Classes. For amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult if as of December 1<sup>st</sup> of the current show year they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher within the past two show years. Fences are not to exceed 2'6". Riders in this division cannot show in any other recognized classes at the same show where the fences exceed 2'6".

### 40. RIHA HUNT SEAT MINI-MEDAL

Entry Fee \$25.00

Open to junior members of the Rhode Island Horseman's Association who have not reached their fifteenth birthday and to riders 15-17 years of age who are eligible for limit equitation over fences as of December 1 in current show year and have not competed in classes in which the entry may be required to jump higher than three feet. All contestants are to compete over a course not exceeding eight fences and not less than six fences, excluding combination fences, at a height not to exceed 2'6", with at least 1 change of direction. One or more individual tests may be requested, at the judge's discretion. (USEF Current test 1-8). To fill a class at least four competitors must complete the course. Contestants are not allowed to cross enter into any medal classes with fences 3' or higher or compete in a division or class with fences over 3' at any show during the year. Violation of this requirement disqualifies the competitor from the finals. The second place competitor shall qualify if the first place rider is disqualified and the class requirements are followed. RIHA Min I Medal Finals the top six contestants are to be tested (USEFG Current Test 1-8).

### 32. RIHA AMATEUR ADULT HUNT SEAT MINI MEDAL

Entry Fee \$25.00

Open to adult amateur riders who, as of December 1<sup>st</sup> of the current show year, have not won six blue ribbons at a RECOGNIZED show in Adult Equitation classes, including Adult Medal Classes, but excluding Modified Adult Classes. For amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult if, as of December 1<sup>st</sup> of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher within the past two show years. Potential qualifiers will be asked to perform over at least six fences not to exceed 2'6" with no combinations. USEF Tests 1-8 may be asked at the judge's discretion. A minimum of three exhibitors must complete the course. To qualify for the finals, an exhibitor must win one class. Once qualified a rider may continue to show in this class.

### 39. MHJ MINI MEDAL 2' 6" Entry Fee \$25.00

Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders are not to compete in any other class that require jumping fences any higher than 18". To be shown over 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". The fences shall be cross rails or verticals with no combinations. Riders may not cross enter into any other medal classes at the MHJ/NEHJ finals. To fill a class, at least two competitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to qualify for the finals. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 1, 2009. After August 1, 2009 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class.

### 31. MHJ ADULT MINI-MEDAL 2'6" Entry Fee \$25.00

Open to all Adult Amateur competitors that have not shown over a course where the fences exceeded 3' in the current year. To perform over a course of at least 6 fences not to exceed 2'6". Competitors may not cross enter into the MHJ Adult Medal or NEHJ Adult talent Medal. To fill a class, at least two competitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to qualify for the finals. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 1, 2009. After August 1, 2009 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class.

### 59. MHJ JUNIOR MEDAL 2'9" Entry Fee \$25.00

Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthdays as of December 1, 2008. Riders shall perform over at least 6 fences not to exceed 3'. Competitors may cross enter in the NEHJ Junior Talent Medal. To fill a class, at

## LEADLINE DIVISION

Entry Fee \$50 per Division \$20.00 Per Class

Open to riders 6 years of age or under. To be shown collectively at the walk, and individually at the trot or jog. To be judged with emphasis on Equitation; also suitability and manners of mount to be considered. Leader to be on foot and must be over 14 years of age. Appropriate dress required for rider, but leader need not be in riding attire but must be neatly and appropriately dressed. Appointments not required.

Shall be judged on manners, performance, and quality in that order.
