Class Descriptions

1. Lead Line Equitation -RIHA rated "A"

Open to riders 6 years of age and under. To be shown at the walk and individually at the trot or jog. To be judged with emphasis on equitation; also suitability and manners of mount to be considered. Leader shall be on foot and at least 14 years of age. Riders may not compete in any other classes except: Leadline Eq Championship or Lead Line Suitability.

2. Lead Line Equitation Championship-unrated

3. Lead Line Suitability-RIHA rated "C"

Open to riders 6 years of age and under. To be shown at the walk and individually at the trot or jog. To be judged with emphasis on suitability and manners of mount. Leader shall be on foot and at least 14 years of age. Riders may not compete in any other class except Lead line.

Walk Trot Equitation- NEHC/RIHA rated "A"

Open to riders 10 years of age or younger. Shall be shown at the walk, trot or jog only. No child entered may compete in any class requiring them to canter or lope. To compete in the Championship class entries must have competed in class #8.

8. Walk/ Trot Equitation

9. Walk/Trot Equitation Championship

4. Senior Walk Trot Equitation- unrated

Open to riders over the age of 10. Shall be shown at the walk, trot or jog only. No child/adult entered may compete in any class requiring them to canter or lope. To compete in the Championship class entries must have competed in class #4.

5. Senior Walk/Trot Equitation Championship

Walk Trot Pleasure-NEHC/RIHA rated "C"

Open to riders 10 years of age or younger. Shall be shown at the walk, trot or jog only. No child entered may compete in any class requiring them to canter or lope. To be judged on manners, suitability of horse/pony to rider and performance. To compete in the Championship class entries must have competed in class #10.

10. Walk/ Trot Pleasure

11. Walk/Trot Pleasure Championship

12. Walk/Trot Trail

Senior Walk Trot Pleasure- unrated

Open to riders over the age of 10. Shall be shown at the walk, trot or jog only. No Child/Adult entered may compete in any class requiring them to canter or lope. To be judged on manners, suitability of horse/pony to rider and performance. To compete in the Championship class entries must have competed in class #6.

6. Senior Walk/Trot Pleasure

7. Senior Walk/Trot Pleasure Championship

13. RIHA Pleasure-RIHA Rated "C"

Open to horses usually used for pleasure purposes that are owned by a members of the RI Horseman's Association. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring, with light rein, but still maintaining contact with horse's mouth. Must be asked to back. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality in that order.

14 NEHC Open Pleasure Horse or Pony-NEHC rated "C"

To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring, with light rein, but still maintaining contact with horse's mouth. Must be asked to back. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality in that order. All horse's/ponies shall be judged on their respective merits regardless of type.

15. Hunter Pleasure NEHC/RIHA rated "A"

Open to all horses of hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to the status of the rider. To be shown at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance, and soundness.

16. Hunter Pleasure Championship \$25, \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

To be eligible the horse must have been entered and judged in the open class. Specifications the same as for the open class.

Hunter Type Pet Pony-NEHC/RIHA rated "A"

Open to riders under 14 years of age. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability to rider. To be eligible for the championship class you must have competed in class #17.

18. Hunter Type Pet Pony Championship \$25, \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

19 QH Western Pleasure-NEHC/RIHA rated "C"

20. QH Hunter under saddle-NEHC/RIHA rated "C"

21. QH Junior to ride-RIHA rated "C"

22. QH Championship-RIHA rated "C" Must have shown in at least one other QH class.

Short Stirrup Equitation-NEHC/RIHA rated "A"

Open to riders 12 years of age or younger. Not to compete in any other equitation class at any show and has not competed in a jumping class exceeding 18" in height. To be shown over a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 fences not exceeding 18" in height. Fences may be taken at either a trot or canter at the option of the rider. To be judged at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on the flat. May be asked to halt and back. No more than eight riders to canter at one time.

23 & 24. Short Stirrup Equitation over fences

25. Short Stirrup Equitation over fences Championship

32. Short Stirrup Equitation on the flat

29. MHJ Short Stirrup Medal

Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders may not compete in any other equitation class at any show and shall not have competed in a class jumping over 18" in height. To be shown over 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". The fences shall be cross rails or verticals with no combinations.

Long Stirrup Equitation-RIHA rated "A"

Open to riders 13 years of age or older. Not to compete in any other equitation class at any show and has not competed in a jumping class exceeding 18" in height or has no shown in classes exceeding 18" in height or higher in the past 10 years. To be judged at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on the flat.

30. Long Stirrup Equitation over fences

34. Long Stirrup Equitation on the flat

Modified Amateur Adult Equitation-NEHC/RIHA rated "A"

Open to adult amateur riders who, as of December 1st of the current show year, has not won 6 blue ribbons at a recognized show in Adult equitation classes. Including Adult medal classes but excluding Modified adult classes. For amateurs who have won 6 blue ribbons, they eligible for Modified Adult, if as of December 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fenced 3' or higher within the past 2 years. Fences not to exceed 2' 6". Riders in this division may not ride in any other recognized classes at the same show where fences exceed 2' 6"

43 & 44. Modified Amateur Adult Eq. over fences

46. MHJ Adult Mini Medal – MHJ Adult Mini-Medal specs: Open to all Adult Amateur riders that have not shown over a course where the fences exceeded 3' in the current year. To perform over a course of at least 8 fences not to exceed 2' 6".

45. Modified Amateur Adult Equitation on the flat

47. RIHA Amateur Adult Mini Medal

Open to adult amateur riders of the RI Horseman's Association who, as of December 1st of the current show year, has not won 6 blue ribbons at a recognized show in Adult equitation classes. Including Adult medal classes but excluding Modified adult classes. For amateurs who have won 6 blue ribbons, they eligible for Modified Adult, if as of December 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher within the past 2 years. Fences not to exceed 2' 6". Riders in this division cannot ride in any other recognized classes at the same show where fences exceed 2' 6" Competitors will be asked to compete over a course of at least 6 fences 2' 6" in height with no combinations. USEF tests 1-8 may be asked at the judge's discretion. A minimum of 3 riders must complete the course. To qualify for the finals an exhibitor must win one class. Once qualified a rider may continue to show in this class.

48. Open Hunt Seat Equitation 14 and under on the flat-NEHC/RIHA rated "A"
50 & 53. .Open Hunt Seat Equitation 14 and under over fences-NEHC/RIHA rated "B"

51. MHJ Mini Medal

Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 15th Birthday of December 1, 2011 with the exception of Maiden and Novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1. To perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 2' 6".

52. RIHA Mini Medal

Open to Junior riders who have not reached their 15th birthday and riders 15-17 years of age who are not eligible for limit equitation over fences as do December 1st of the current show year and has not competed in classes which the entry may be required to jump higher than 3'. All riders to compete over a course not exceeding 8 fences and not less than 6 fences at a height not to exceed 2' 6" with at least one change of direction. One or more individual test may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF tests 1-8) To fill the class at least 4 or more competitors must complete the course. Contestants are not allowed to cross enter into any medal classes with fences 3' or higher or compete in a division or class with fences over 3' at any show during the year. Violation of this requirement qualifies the competitor from the finals. RIHA Mini Medal Finals top 6 contestants are to be tested (USEF 1-8).

Children's Equitation-NEHC/RIHA rated "A"

Open to exhibitors who are eligible for Children's Hunter and who have not shown over a course where fences exceed 3' at a recognized show after December 1st of the current year.

54 .55 & 56. Children's Equitation over fences

86. MHJ Children's Medal Qualifier) – MHJ Children's Medal specs: Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1, 2011 and who have not shown over a course where the fences have exceeded 3'. Fence heights Small/Medium 2' and Large & Horses 2'6".

60. Children's Equitation on the flat

Amateur Adult Hunter Seat Equitation-NEHC/RIHA rated "A"

Open to amateur riders, eighteen years or older. Fences not to exceed 3'. To be judged in both directions at the walk, trot and canter on the flat. Martingales prohibited in flat classes.

66. Amateur Adult Equitation on the flat

67. Amateur Adult Equitation over fences

Open Hunt Seat Equitation Under 18-NEHC/RIHA rated "A"

68. Under 18 Equitation on the flat

70. MHJ Amateur Adult Medal

Open to all Adult Amateur riders. Riders shall perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3' including a combination with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the Judge's discretion.

71. RIHA Amateur Adult Medal

Open to amateur adult members of the RI Horseman's Association. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3' with at least 1 change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF test 1-19). To fill a class at least 3 competitors must complete the course. For the finals, the judge shall require to work-off the top 4 competitors. One first or two seconds to qualify for the finals.

72. NEHC Amateur Adult Medal

Open to adult members of the New England Horseman's Council. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be required at the judge's discretion (USEF 1-19). To fill a class at least four competitors must

complete the course. Contestants that are qualified are no longer eligible for the preliminary class. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.

73. MHJ Junior Medal

Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1, 2011. Riders shall perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the Judge's discretion.

74. RIHA Junior Medal

Open to junior members of the RI Horseman's Association who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3' with at least 1 change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF test 1-19). To fill a class at least 3 competitors must complete the course. For the finals, the judge shall require to work-off the top 4 competitors. One first or two seconds to qualify for the finals.

76. NEHC Junior Medal

Open to junior members of the New England Horseman's Council who have not reached their eighteenth birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not to exceed 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be required at the judge's discretion (USEF1-19). To fill a class at least four competitors must complete the course. One win required to qualify for the finals. Contestants that are qualified are no longer eligible for the preliminary class. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.

85. Bareback Maclay - unrated

No restriction as to status of horse or rider. Riders to compete over a course of 2' fences riding bareback and then return for a flat phase. To be judged on equitation. Finals to be held at the November 2012 show.

Hunter Divisions

Pre-Children's Hunter-NEHC/RIHA rated "A"

Open to junior riders who have not competed in classes which require a rider to jump higher than 2'. May show a horse or pony. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring.

35, 36 & 41. Pre-Children's Hunter over fences \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

37. Pre-Children's Hunter under saddle \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

Short Stirrup Hunter-NEHC/RIHA rated "AA"

Open to riders 12 years of age or younger. Not to compete in any other equitation class at any show and has not competed in a jumping class exceeding 18" in height. To be shown over a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 fences not exceeding 18" in height. Fences may be taken at either a trot or canter at the option of the rider. To be judged at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on the flat. No more than eight riders to canter at one time.

26, 27 & 28. Short Stirrup Hunter over fences \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

33. Short Stirrup Hunter under saddle \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

Children's Hunter Division-NEHC/RIHA rated "B"

To be shown by junior exhibitors. Juniors 15-17 must be eligible for intermediate equitation over fences as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences not to exceed 2' of small/medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies and 3' for horses. Spreads not to exceed fence height. If extras warrant, the division may be split at the discretion of the show management. Same horse/pony/rider combination may not show in any other rated division except equitation at the same show. Ponies may not cross enter into regular Pony Hunter Division. Jogging for soundness at the discretion of the judge.

57, 58 & 59. Children's Hunter over fences \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

61. Children's Hunter under saddle \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

RIHA Hunter Division-RIHA rated "A"

Open to members and non-members. Horse/rider combination is not eligible for any other RIHA, or NEHC classes excluding equitation. Open to a horse or rider in their first and second year of showing over fences. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

38, 39 & 49. RIHA Hunter over fences \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

40. RIHA Hunter under saddle \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

Modified Pony Hunters-RIHA rated "A"

Fences to be 2'. A pony/rider combination may not cross into any other hunter class over fences except Pre-Children's Hunters or equitation at the same show.

62, 63 & 64. Modified Pony Hunter over fences \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

65. Modified Pony Hunter under saddle \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

Green Pony Hunter-NEHC/RIHA rated "A"

A green pony is a pony of any age not exceeding 14.2 hands that has not been shown over fences the regulation height or higher for its respective sections (2'3" for small, 2'6" for medium and 2'9" for large) prior to December 1st of the current competition year. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, responsive, and move freely. To be judged on performance and soundness.

77 & 78. Green Pony Hunter over fences \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

79. Green Pony Hunter Stake \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

83. Green Pony Hunter under saddle \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

Pony Hunter-NEHC/RIHA rated "A"

To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, and suitability as a hunter. Ponies may be jogged for soundness at Judge's discretion. Fences for ponies not exceeding 12.2 hands 2'3" and fences 2'6" for ponies over 12.2 but not exceeding 13.2 hands. Fences for ponies over 13.2 and not exceeding 14.2 hands 3'.

80 & 81. Pony Hunter over fences \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

82. Pony Hunter Stake \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

84. Pony Hunter under saddle \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

Rules and Regulations

1. All judge's decisions are final. No exhibitor or person shall approach a judge on any matter without show manager's permission. Anyone disregarding this rule may be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit all entry fees.
2. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes if in its opinion the entries to warrant.
3. There will be a post entry fee of \$20.00 for all entries received after 4:00 pm the day before the show. There will be no penalty for entering additional classes the day of the show. – WAIVED WITH DONATION OF PAPER GOODS to Angels on Horseback Therapeutic Riding Program.
4. There will be a \$50.00 fee for all returned checks.
5. A trophy and 6 ribbons will be presented in all classes unless otherwise stated or money given.
6. All exhibitors are prohibited from riding anywhere on show grounds without wearing protective headgear that has passed the current ASTM/SEI standards. Harnesses must be secured and if said headgear has a brim, it must be flexible or semi-flexible. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until said headgear is properly in place.
7. All dogs must be on a leash.
8. Membership forms and class specifications are available at the secretary's office.
9. Under Rhode Island law, an equine professional, unless he can be shown to have failed to be in the exercise of due care, is not liable for any injury to, or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Chapter 21, of Title 4 of the General laws.
10. Courses will consist of post, rail, walls, gates, brush and flowers..
11. All riders must present their current RIHA and NEHC membership cards or a copy thereof to the show secretary prior to competing in the RIHA and NEHC medal classes.
12. No exhibitor numbers will be handed out without a signed check or payment of entries.
13. Championship and Reserve Championship ribbons will be handed out in all divisions.
14. Schooling and lunging will be permitted in authorized areas only. Anyone found violating this rule will forfeit their entry fees and not be allowed to show.
15. Regular classes will be \$25.00. Medal and all money classes will be \$35.00.
